Policy: Hold public lectures and community education activities, including regular activities and aperiodic activities, so that the community and the general public can participate according to their own training and learning needs.</p> <p>2. Results:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The School of Continuing Education of our school offers a variety of language learning courses, including English, Japanese, Korean, French, Vietnamese, German, etc., allowing community residents to develop their second foreign language skills according to their learning interests. A total of 19 classes were held in 2020, with 1,849 hours of lessons. A total of 582 people completed the course. 2. To provide elderly persons in the community with opportunities to continue studying, our school opened the Changhua County Senior College in 1995 to encourage senior citizens over 55 years of age registered in the county to return to the campus to study. There were two semesters in 2020. Each semester lasted 16 weeks. A total of 19 classes were opened. A total of 609 people graduated. 3. Every year, to cooperate with the Ministry of Education and meet the needs of secondary school teachers for further study, a second specialty and enhancement class for teachers is set up to assist on-the-job teachers to improve their professional teaching capabilities. A total of 26 courses were opened in 2020, with training hours reaching 1,080 and a total of 792 participants. 4. To assist on-the-job individuals to continue their education and enhance their professional skills in the workplace, our school plans vocational training courses according to the needs of community residents and local industries. In 2020, a total of 87 classes were opened, with total training hours exceeding 2,588. A total of 2,178 trainees were given assistance to improve their knowledge and abilities. 5. Various types of education promotion courses are held from time to time, covering business operations, information technology, business management, marketing, and handicraft creation, etc., so that the community residents can continue to grow according to their own learning interests. A total of 65 classes were opened in 2020, attracting 1,618 registrations.
