1. Project Summary :

To enhance the special education knowledge of special education teachers, administrators, and related counsellors at all stages of education in the counselling area, we conduct an annual pre-investigation of the practical needs and proportion of disability categories of students served, combining the special education policies of the Ministry of Education and future development direction of special education. Based on the results of the pre-investigation, we research and plan special education knowledge studies, topic-based case studies, special case handling sessions, visits to excellent companies, workshops, and other professional knowledge activities.

In 2020, we planned and held 13 special education knowledge training sessions, 4 topic-based case studies, 2 special case handling sessions, 1 visit to an excellent company, 6 workshops, and 26 professional knowledge activities.

2. Achievements :

In 2020, we held 26 professional knowledge activities, as analysed in Tables 1 - 4.
