### 1. Project Summary:

In addition to counselling students with disabilities attending our school, the Special Education Centre also assists special education teachers and related staff through seminars, workshops, and regular publication of special education publications in the counselling area (central area). In addition, we assist the professional growth of special education teachers and related staff. We solve issues related to special education teaching and upbringing for special education teachers, parents, students, and relevant staff through the consultation hotline.

### 2. Achievements :

In addition to providing special education consulting services for current teachers, special education students, parents, and the community, the centre also hosts special education visits from colleges and universities. Furthermore, the centre regularly publishes special education publications to enhance the professionalism and service of special education professionals.

(I) The special education consulting service period in 2020 was from 2 March 2020 to 30 June 2020 and from 14 September 2020 to 31 December 2020. In total, 26 people were served. We assisted teachers, parents, and education administrators in the tutoring district at all stages of education in dealing with the teaching, tutoring, identification, placement, and parental education of special education students. We specifically hired special education experts and scholars to provide special education telephone consultation and interview services.

(II) In 2020, there were ten school visits of colleges and universities to our school to guide our special education. For school visits and counselling, the schedule for the schools we accepted as visitors was as follows: 6/29: National Chi Nan University and Nan Kai University of Technology, 7/22: National Changhua University of Education and Chienkuo Technology University, 7/29: MingDao University and National Formosa University, 7/ 30: National Yunlin University of Science and Technology and TransWorld University, 8/18: Dayeh University and Chung Chou University of Science and Technology.

(III) In 2020, the Special Education Journal published four special education gardener

journals. Each issue accumulates the special education research and practice of many special education teachers, counsellors, and related professional teams at various stages of education on different topics. In 2020, 1,400 donated special education publications were distributed or awarded to 277 units including the education bureau (divisions), special education schools, special education resource centres, special education departments (centres) of colleges and universities, and libraries countrywide. This act aims to enhance the growth of education-related personnel countrywide in the special education profession.
