NCUE has more than 220 partner universities around the world, of which 28 are located in underdeveloped and developing countries. Despite the continuous escalation of the COVID-19 pandemic worldwide, the University maintains its exchanges with its partners through online and offline channels, including teacher training, internships, school activities, lectures, cooperative research, and academic conferences, to enhance the international participation of teachers and students, as well as to provide professional assistance to its partners based on the University's academic and educational foundations. The exchange activities cover countries such as India, Indonesia, Vietnam, Ukraine, and Ghana in Africa. Some examples of the activities are as follows:

1. (1) From October 1st to 3rd, 2021, NCUE, Chinese Indigenous Social Science Association, and World Indigenous Counseling Psychology Alliance jointly held an international academic seminar. Scholars from Indonesia and other countries were invited to participate in the meeting virtually.





(2) The NCUE International Office held a meeting with Berdyansk State Pedagogical University from Ukraine to discuss cooperative and exchange programs.



(3) On October 29, 2021, the NCUE International Office held a meeting with 19 higher-education institutions in Vietnam to discuss exchange and cooperative agreements.



(4) On November 12, 2021, the NCUE International Office and Professor Chen Yiwen from the Department of Sports held a meeting with the Surabaya University of Technology in Indonesia and the University of Raman in Malaysia to discuss short-term co-teaching programs.



(5) From November 25th to 26th, 2021, the NCUE International Office participated in the Indonesian Education Forum, discussed cooperation programs with Indonesian UIN Maulana Malik Ibrahim Malang, and signed a memorandum of understanding.



(6) On December 15, 2021, the NCUE International Office held a meeting with the Central University of Ghana, Africa, discussing the Elite Scholarship Program and NCUE International Master Program in Engineering.





(7) On December 23, 2021, the NCUE International Office and the SMK Theresiana Semarang, Indonesia, organized a meeting to discuss enrollment issues.





(8) On December 24, 2021, the NCUE International Office, the deans of the College of Science and the College of Engineering and the Karpagam Academy of Higher Education in India held a meeting to discuss a memorandum of understanding, student exchange programs, and academic exchanges and joint research projects in science and engineering.





(9) On January 8 and 13, 2021, the NCUE International Office and Director Ho from the SMK Theresiana Semarang held meetings with the conveners of Jakarta and Semarang areas,

Indonesia, respectively, regarding student recruitment.
